

Chaplaincy Training 2024

We have three **Chaplaincy Training** programmes scheduled in 2024. These courses will be taking place in person, based at SYCLS' training room in **Sheffield City Centre**. Each course consists of **2-days** of training:

April course: Thurs 18th & Fri 19th April

June course: Mon 17th & Tues 18th June

September course: Tues 10th & Wed 11th September

What is covered?

The course covers:

- An overview of the origin of Chaplaincy and its development in the UK & South Yorkshire
- What is Chaplaincy?
- The role of a Chaplain
- Qualities of a Chaplain
- The difference between Spirituality and Religion and an overview of Christian theology of Chaplaincy care
- Practicalities of visiting an organisation within different contexts, holding conversations & note-taking.

Sessions include opportunities to ask questions, explore case studies & scenarios together, and to consider whether Chaplaincy is the right route for you. **The training is delivered by 2 South Yorkshire Chaplaincy & Listening Service trainers who are also working as Chaplains.**

The course is aimed at prospective and new chaplains and forms part of our recruitment and training process for people who want to volunteer as Chaplains with us.

Cost

The cost of the training is £50 per person if you are attending for your own purposes. For potential SYCLS volunteers, the training fee is paid for, but we ask if you would consider making an optional donation of £10 towards the costs of training. To be eligible for this reduced training fee, you must have sent in your Volunteer Application Form before training.
