

# Children's Listening Training

## Who This Is For

For anyone who interacts with children including parents, carers, teachers, TAs, youth leaders and children's workers.

We are offering a programme of training courses which can be done in bite size chunks or altogether.

The training considers how to listen to children, with skills you can adapt and apply. No previous training is required.

## Training Options

### **Children's Listening, Module 1 (2 days for £200)**

*May (Tuesday 12th & Wednesday 13th).*

A foundational course focused on developing listening skills that can be used with children. This includes providing safe spaces for children to talk freely and supporting them to process situations.

### **Children's Listening, Module 2 (2 days for £200)**

*June (Tuesday 16th & Wednesday 17th).*

*Module 1 must be completed first.* The course explores how to adapt your approach for different ages, including declarative language, inclusive listening and safe prompting.



The following courses can be taken as optional stand-alone sessions:

### **Children & Loss (£100)**

*July (Wednesday 8th)*

This course explores the impact of loss and grief on children and how adults can support them in processing these experiences. This may include the loss and/or separation of parent(s), a family member or main carer.

### **Non-verbal Listening (£100)**

*July (Thursday 9th)*

This course focuses on listening to children through non-verbal and creative approaches. It includes listening through play and colouring, and signposting to useful resources.

This programme of courses will be repeated in 2027 years therefore you can do them over time or all this year.
